Registration and abstract submission

LaTex abstracts should be prepared in according standard template file and should not exceed 1 page. We kindly ask you to follow the rules, indicated in the template file.

The abstract template file is downloadable from the conference WEB.

Until July 15, 2014 you will be notified whether your contribution is included into the program.

Visa information

Visa affair is the easiest part of the travel. Citizens of many countries do not need an entrance visa for Georgia (citizens of EU countries, USA, Japan, Israel, Turkey, Canada, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Ukraine, etc.). Citizens of some countries, including citizens of Russia, can obtain a visa while crossing the border of Georgia at official checkpoints, including all airports of Georgia.

Travel information

Batumi can be reached both from **Tbilisi** and from **Istanbul** by airplane (daily flights in summer), also from some other airports in Europe (see the conference WEB). You can also use the new **Kutaisi (Kopitnari) international airport (Code KUT).** The Batumi airport is very close to the city. Batumi is about 350 km west from Tbilisi, about 6 hours by train, bus, or car and 150 km. from Kopitnari airport.

Accommodation
