A limited number of articles will be selected by the respective section chairs and will be published after going through a standard peer review process.

Late submissions will not be accepted. LATEX abstracts should be prepared in English according to the standard template file. Abstracts in different formats will not be accepted by the organizing committee. A pdf file of the abstract should not exceed 1 page. We kindly ask you to follow the rules indicated in the template file. The abstract template file¹ can be downloaded from the conference webpage.

Attention: Your registration will be considered complete and your abstract will be published in the Book of Abstracts if the abstract is approved by the Scientific Committee and the registration fee is paid.
