The XIII International Conference of the Georgian Mathematical Union (GMU2023) will be held on **September 4-9, 2023, in Batumi**, a Black Sea resort in Georgia.

The Conference venue: Batumi Shota Rustaveli State University located at 35 Ninoshvili St., 6010 Batumi, Georgia; (webpage: http://www.bsu.edu.ge/).

The conference will be held in a hybrid format.

Thematic Mini-symposia: Participants wishing to organize mini-symposia are invited to send applications with a title and description of the topic to conferences.gmu@gmail.com before June 15, 2023. To launch a mini-symposium, there should be at least five speakers.

It is planned to publish conference proceedings in the international "Journal of Mathematical Sciences" (Springer, https://www.springer.com/journal/10958), which is indexed in Scopus. A limited number of articles will be selected by the respective section chairs and will undergo a standard peer review process before publication.

Abstract submission: Please visit the website http://gmu.gtu.ge/conferences/batumi2023/registration/ to register and submit LATEX and pdf files of your abstracts before July 15, 2023.

Late submissions will not be accepted. LATEX abstracts should be prepared in English according to the standard template file. Abstracts in different formats will not be accepted by the organizing committee. The PDF file of the abstract should not exceed **one** page. We kindly ask you to follow the rules indicated in the template file¹, which can be downloaded from the conference website.

Fees for the GMU2023 Conference:

For Master's and PhD Students: 50 Euros For other participants: 100 Euros

Ukrainian mathematicians participating in the conference will be exempt from the conference fee.

Attention: Your registration will only be considered complete and your abstract will be published in the Book of Abstracts if both the Scientific Committee approves your abstract and you have paid the registration fee.

Visa Information: Getting a visa for Georgia is often the easiest part of travel. Citizens of many countries, including EU countries, the USA, Japan, Israel, Turkey, Iran, Canada, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Ukraine, and Russia, do not need an entrance visa. For more precise information, please check the website https://new.geoconsul.gov.ge/en/entering-georgia. However, citizens of some countries, such as India, Pakistan, etc., will need to apply for a visa at the Consulate of Georgia in their own country or the nearest location. Travel Information: Getting to Batumi is easy, with several transportation options available. Batumi can be reached from Tbilisi, Istanbul, and some other cities in Europe. The Alexander Kartveli Batumi International Airport is conveniently located close to the city centre. Participants can also use the David the Builder Kutaisi International Airport (Kopitnari), which is about 250 km from Batumi, with a comfortable bus connecting the two cities. If travelling from Tbilisi, Batumi is about 375 km to the west and can be reached in approximately 5-6 hours by train or bus.

Accommodation: There are several options for booking accommodation in Batumi. You can reserve a hotel room through websites like https://www.booking.com/. Alternatively, you can find private apartments to rent on websites like https://www.airbnb.com/. Detailed information about some hotels and tours in the frame of social program is also available on the conference website.
