We kindly ask you to follow the rules indicated in the [template file](#). The [abstract template file](#)¹ can be downloaded from the conference webpage.

July 15, 2026 - Deadline for abstract submission.

July 20, 2026 - Notification of acceptance.

July 31, 2026 - Deadline for payment of the Conference Fee for those participants who want to include the abstract in the Book of Abstracts.
