The XVI International Conference of the Georgian Mathematical Union will be held on **August 31 - September 5, 2026, in Batumi**, Black Sea resort of Georgia.

It is planned to publish conference proceedings in the international "Journal of Mathematical Sciences" (Springer, <https://www.springer.com/journal/10958>), which is indexed in the Scopus. A limited number of articles will be selected by the respective section chairs and will be published after going through a standard peer review process.

Late submissions will not be accepted. LaTeX abstracts should be prepared in English according to the standard template file. Abstracts in different formats will not be accepted by the organizing committee. A pdf file of the abstract should not exceed 1 page. We kindly ask you to follow the rules indicated in the template file. The abstract template file can be downloaded from the [conference webpage](#).

Payment	Foreign participants will be allowed to pay the conference fee on-site during the registration. In this case, such participants have to inform the Organizing Committee in advance, before July 31, concerning on-site payment.

Attention: Your registration will be considered completed and your abstract will be published in the Book of Abstracts if the abstract is approved by the Scientific Committee and the registration fee is paid.

Visa Information: Visa affair is the easiest part of the travel. Citizens of many countries do not need an entrance visa for Georgia (citizens of EU countries, USA, Japan, Israel, Turkey, Iran, Canada, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Ukraine, Russia, etc.). Citizens of some countries, including citizens of India, Pakistan etc., should apply for a visa in Consulates of Georgia in their own or nearest countries. Travel Information: Batumi can be reached from **Tbilisi**, from **Istanbul** and some other cities of Europe. The **Batumi airport** is very close to the city. Participants can also use the **Kutaisi International Airport** (150 km to Batumi with a comfortable bus). Batumi is about 350 km west from Tbilisi, about 5 hours by train / bus.
